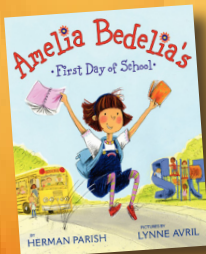

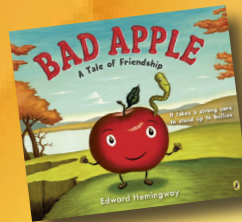


ABC ZooBorns!

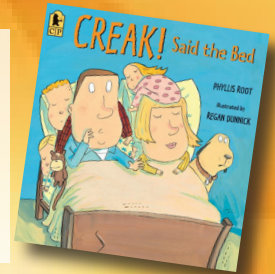
Bad Apple

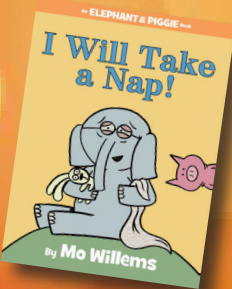
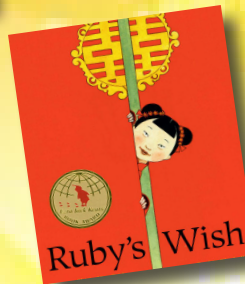
Creak! Said the Bed

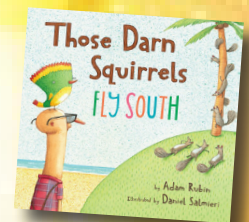


I Will Take a Nap!

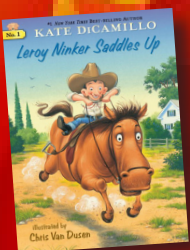
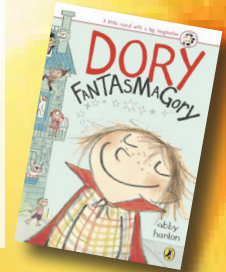
Captain Underpants: The Sensational Saga of Sir Stinks-A-Lot

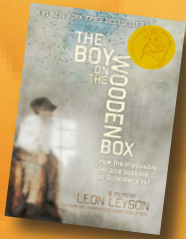

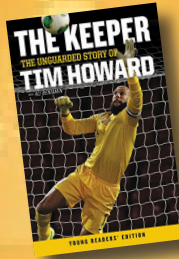
The Boy on the Wooden Box

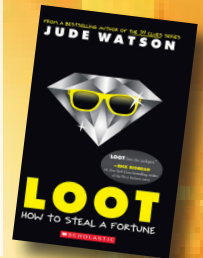
The Land of Stories: A Grimm Warning

Jason Segel

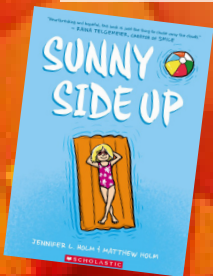

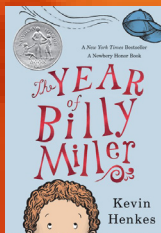
Sunny Side Up
