

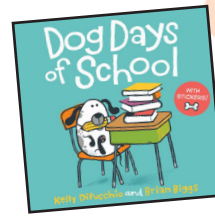

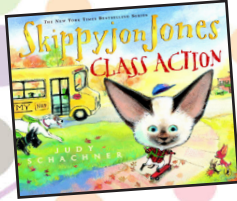
**Hooray for Hat!**

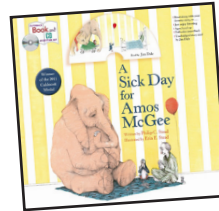
**Lion vs. Rabbit**

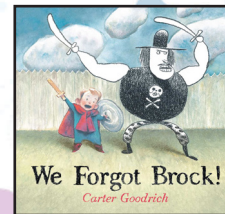


**A Sick Day for Amos McGee: Book & CD Storytime**

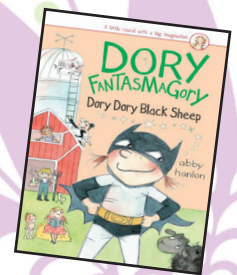


**Dog Man 3 A Tale of Two Kitties**

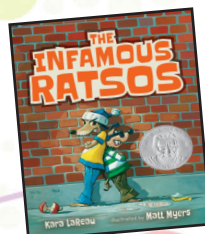
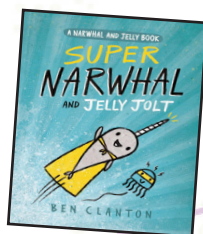
**Dory Fantasmagory 3: Dory Dory Black Sheep**

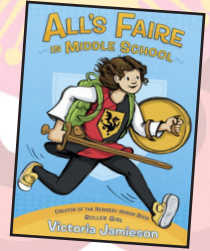
### Adventurer's Guide to Successful Escapes by Wade Albert White

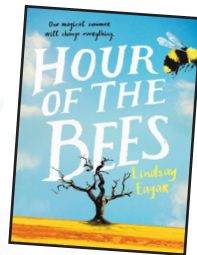


### Ghost by Jason Reynolds

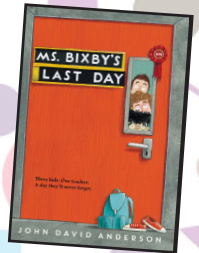
### Hour of the Bees by Lindsay Eagar
